Gallup Navajo Racism Survey

Participants must:

1. Be over 18 years of age
2. Must live within Gallup city limits now
3. Be a Navajo Indian- other American Indians cannot participate in this particular study.

Survey seeks:

Navajo who have:

- Graduated from high school
- Dropped out of high school
- Were expelled from high school
- Have problems with alcohol, police, school officials, or NOT

Survey is:

- A survey on the perceptions of Gallup Navajo about their high school experience and deals with issues of racism
- Requests some background information
- Is an attempt to seek justice for the Navajo

Risks to Participants:

- There are limited risks to participants
- Participants can stop survey any time and walk away
- Participants can take survey themselves or someone can fill it out for them
- Some issues related to the by-yearly suicide Navajo survey by the Public Health Services are included
- There is no monetary benefit to participating, participating is voluntary, and participants are eligible to win up to three prizes: \$100, \$75, or \$50
